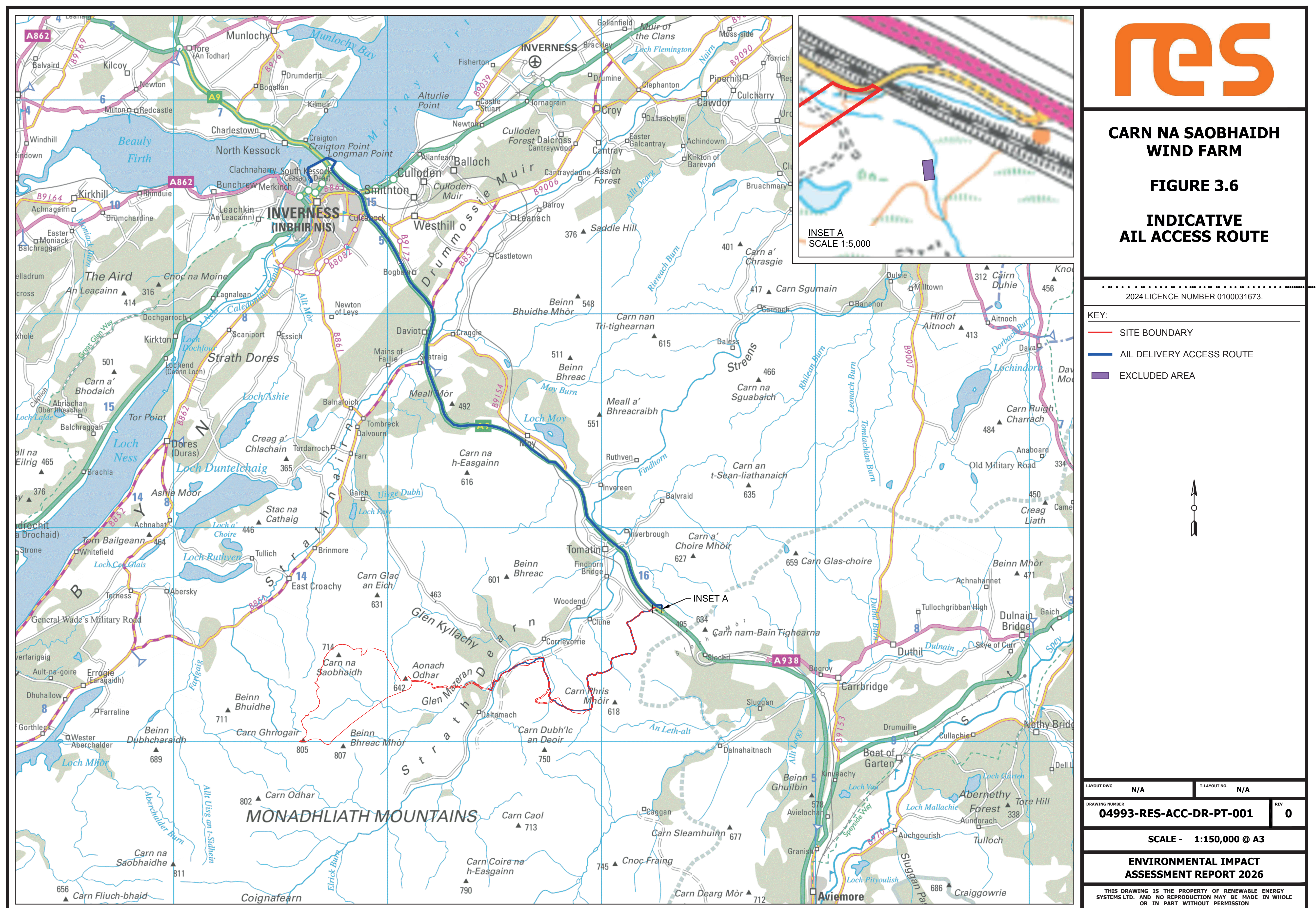


Traffic and Transport



Transport is one of the key considerations when selecting a potential wind farm site, particularly with regard to turbine deliveries.

The delivery route for turbine components is expected to be via the A9 and U2856. Further detail of the delivery route can be found on the interactive screen.

Safety is of upmost importance to RES and we will be undertaking a detailed swept path analysis of the turbine delivery route, as well as careful assessment of the main site access options. The preferred access point and turbine delivery route are shown on the map above.

Over the next few months, we will consult with The Highland Council and Transport Scotland on our transport plans. A transport assessment will be undertaken and, if the wind farm is given consent, a detailed Traffic Management Plan will be agreed with the roads authority and the police. Wherever reasonably practicable we will use materials available on site and source construction materials locally in order to help reduce traffic movements.
